

'Earned Income Vcz 'Credit

Take the Money.



You've earned it.'

Claim the Earned Income Credit (EITC), a tax benefit for people who work. Payments vary based on income and family size. Many working families will get up to \$6,044. Workers can claim the EITC, even if they do not owe income tax, simply by filing federal and state income tax returns. In Maryland, the EITC does not affect food stamps, Medicaid, public housing benefits, cash assistance, or SSI. Even workers with no children may qualify for a small EITC.

Households may qualify for the federal and state EITC if, in 2013, they:

- Were raising one child and earned less than \$37,870*.
- Were raising two or more children and earned less than \$43,038*.
- Has no children, earned less than \$14,340* and were between ages 25 and 64.

**This is the income limit for single workers. The income limit for married workers is \$7,000 higher*
