- Live paycheck to paycheck
- Are part of every community nationwide



















Number of ALICE Households in Frederick County








City of Frederick vs. Rural Communities







This includes only essential household items. In comparison, the Bureau of Labor Statistics' Consumer Price Index (CPI) covers a large group of goods and services that urban consumers buy regularly.










Seniors Living Alone in Frederick County






Internet Access in Frederick County






Housing Problems in Frederick County
