

## Maryland State Overview








Above ALICE Threshold 62%





# Change Over Time in Frederick County






















# Demographics: Age | Frederick County








# Demographics: Family Type | Frederick County








# Demographics: Race/Ethnicity | Frederick County


# Comparison of Inflation in Frederick County



#### Labor Force in Frederick County








#### Disconnected Youth in Frederick County











<sup>\*</sup>This indicator shows the percentage of households headed by someone age 65 or older who lives alone.



#### Internet Access in Frederick County










\*This indicator shows the percentage of households with an internet subscription.
